# Making a trip to Mackinac Island? What to know abut ferry tickets

Mackinac Island, one of the most popular tourism travels destination. is reopening for the 2025 summer season, and the ferry services carrying people to the island are gearing up for summer as

Departing from both St Ignace and Mackinac City, the Arnold Transit Co. ferry and the Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry, owned by the Hoffmann Family of Companies, allow tourists to get back and forth from the island. With island attractions, including the Grand Hotel, opening in the coming days, the ferry companies are expanding their daily

Arnold had rebranded as the Mackinac Island Ferry Company in 2022 to consolidate the Star Line Mackinac Island Hydro-Jet Ferry fleet, which began in the 1970s, the Arnold Line fleet, operational since 1878, and the Mackinac Marine Services shipyard, founded in 2019, according to a 2024 news release by the Hoffmann companies.

Hoffmann Marine acquired Mackinac Island Ferry Company and rebranded it as the Arnold Transit Company, reporting from the Free Press

shows. Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry notes on its website that it is the sole operator providing ferry service to and from Mackinac Island, following the

suspension of operations by Star Line Mackinac Island Ferry Company in 2024.

"Between Michigan's Upper and Lower Peninsulas, you'll find Mackinac Island, where you'll ride on horsedrawn carriages along car-free roads, observe fudge being made (and then sample it), and tour the historic Fort Mackinac," USA TODAY's 2024 10Best Readers' Choice Awards says.

Here's everything to know about the two ferries that cross into Mackinac Island:

# **Arnold Transit Company**

The Arnold Transit Co., founded by in 1878 by George T. Arnold, originally transported passengers and goods on coal-fired steamboats to Michigan ports and islands, its website says.

Arnold now provides ferry services to St Ignace, Mackinaw City and Mackinac Island, with a fleet of ferries to offer a "traditional" ride while the "classic" ride will feature a slightly longer trip time.

"This season, expect smooth sailings, unforgettable views, and a renewed commitment to excellence. Whether you're a first-time visitor or a longtime fan of Arnold, we can't wait to welcome you aboard," its website said.

From April 25 to May 8, departures from both Mackinac City and St. Ignace are hourly. Additional times are slated for the rest of May.

#### **How much do Arnold** ferry tickets cost in 2025?

Tickets for the Arnold Transit Com-

- Traditional ferry ticket, \$34 for an adult round-trip ticket and \$22 for children up to 12.
- Classic ferry ticket, \$22.95 for an adult round-trip ticket and \$17.95 for children.
- Priority ticket, are \$46 for an adult round-trip ticket and \$34 for children.

# **Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry**

Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry, known for its lighthouse, Fourth of July and night sky cruises, offers departures from both Mackinaw City and St. Ig-

Once peak season hits Shepler's will start its annual fast turnaround, 15minute departure schedule. The full schedule is available on the company

Shepler's service expands to hourly beginning April 25 and continuing through May 22. Then, until the end of August, departures increase again.

#### How much are Shepler's tickets in 2025?

For an adult round trip, tickets are \$36, children up to 12 are \$24. Credit card transactions are subject to a 3% fee.

"Enhanced" ticket options, with preferred boarding and other perks, cost an additional \$12.

Other fees include:

• Bikes: \$21 or \$42 for a tandem bike

• Stroller/wagon: free
